

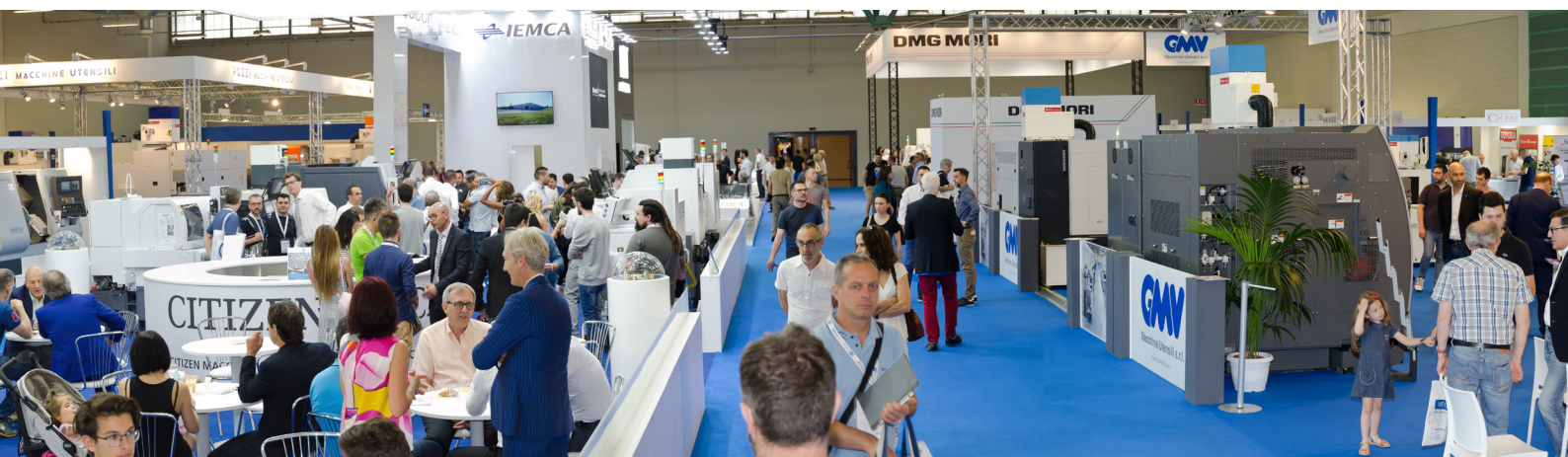

Organizing the first edition of the **Tornitura Show** in Bergamo, last June 2019, was considered by many to be a gamble. A new fair, A new fair in a city outside the usual Italian fair circuit of the engineering sector, a new event in a fair organization perhaps deemed unsuitable for a mechanics event.

We, on the other hand, believed in it a lot right from the start, both in the project and in the location and, even if at first it might seem like only a dream, we worked hard to make the idea come true. The largely positive result was evident in the eyes of all those who had the opportunity to visit or exhibit:

- About **9,000 visitors** in the 3 days of the event
- Present practically **all the main houses represented**
- The **most important supporting trade associations** were present
- **Product news, machining simulations**

While we are starting the organization of the **second edition**, which will also be held in Bergamo from **16 to 18 February 2023**, we are already thinking about the consolidation of the Tornitura Show and the expansion of the offer in terms of content:

- **new workshops** focused on the real needs of users
- **greater presence** at the educational level, and related credits, with direct contact with the main schools
- an **"off the show" event** and a whole series of pluses that will certainly increase the interest of potential visitors.

Our will, for this second edition of the event, remains to recreate an event that is once again "familiar", within which everyone, from large companies to small subcontractors, will be fully-fledged protagonists with equal dignity.

A fundamental part will be covered by the promotion that will be in the main newspapers in the area, on social networks (Facebook and LinkedIn), with dedicated newsletters and directly from our stand at all the fairs we will take part in.

It will never be stressed enough that **Bergamo** is a province with a historical vocation for the mechanical industry and its production fabric is one of the most prepared and receptive to innovation. 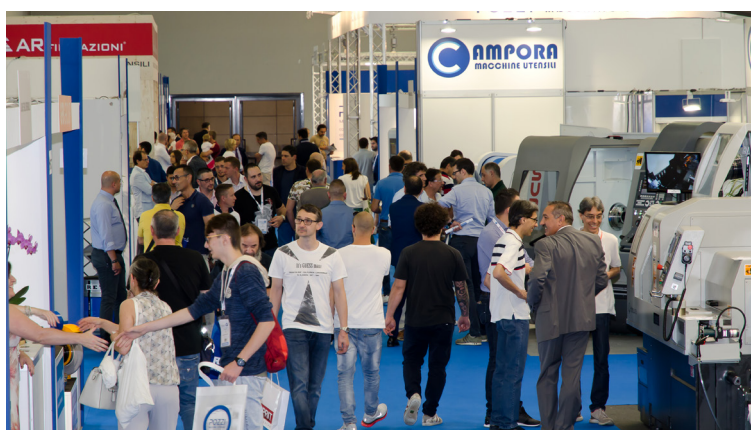

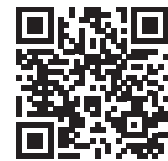
